This document will assist rolling committees and committee members to keep on track with what has already been agreed and help align future actions, decisions and plans so they align with servicing the club, its existing members and new members.


This document is a LIVE document and is intended to be re-written and improved over time.

Different contact methods, on website;


- Committee Member contacts

- 7. What they will need to bring with them to each flying session (Chair, hat, coffee, etc.)




Potential Member

If joined...



Welcome email from Secretary;


- Welcome to RAMS

RAMS


Secretary emails template on "Path to Success" covering information on where to find;

- How do they request to be tested?




Member

and solo flight


RAMS

- Secretary notes members' success for mention in next newsletter


MAAA Bronze Wings

- Bronze Wing certificate from MAAA is forwarded by RAMS Secretary to member
